



What should I wear?

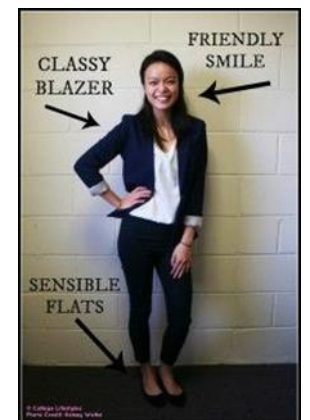
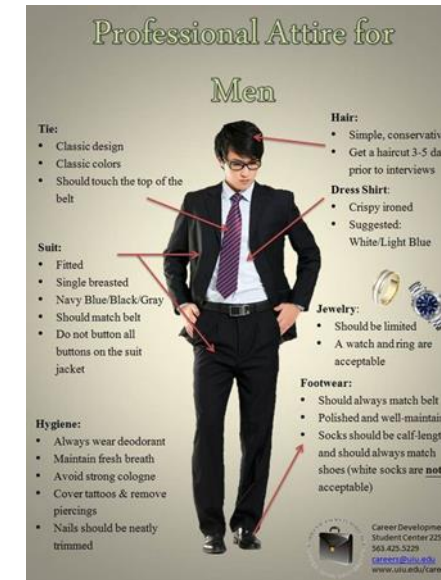
Business Professional

- Yes, you should wear a suit!
- Don't be afraid to ask the Strommen Center for help
 - This is often the first time students have to dress for a job fair
- **Pay attention to what people are wearing in the career fair videos on this Moodle site**
- Suits and business attire can be very expensive – ask around to see if you can borrow something
- Consignment stores (used clothing) often have nice business attire at a low price
- Stores like Kohls, Target, JCPenney, etc. will have nice professional attire at a reasonable price
- If possible, invest in something that will serve as your interview outfit and can be worn with other pieces for future work attire



Job Fair Do's

- Wear clothes that fit, are clean, and wrinkle-free
- Wear comfortable shoes – you'll be on your feet for a long time
- Plan your outfit before the big day
- Neutral colors are best – nothing too patterned or flashy



Job Fair Don'ts

- Short skirts
- Tight or revealing clothing
- Super high heels
- Jeans – not even nice ones!
- Strong cologne or perfume
