Research employers **BEFORE** the fair.

Knowing information about an employer before you attend the Career & Internship Fair is not only helpful and very important, but also expected by employers. You will make a much better impression if you are prepared with some basic information about the organizations attending such an event. Listed

below are recommendations for what you should know about each organization <i>before</i> you attend and information that can typically be found on the organization's website. Feel free to use this handout as a "worksheet" for your preparation. Find the following on each organization that interests you and you'll be well prepared for the Fair.	
1.	What is something that stands out to you about the organization that you admire/find inspiring/makes you want to work there? (mission, populations served, community involvement, awards/recognitions, etc.)
2.	What are the main products and services of the organization?
3.	What is the organization's mission and values?
4.	What is the brief history of the organization (when did they begin, how, where)?
5.	Has there been any recent news related to the employer?
6.	How big is the organization? How many employees do they have?
7.	What positions do they typically hire?
8.	Where are they located? Is there more than one location?
